## Message from the Chair

To CAHME Chronicle Readers:

At this holiday time of the year, I send my best wishes for a wonderful 2012. In this Annual Report issue, we want to say “Thank You” to the 57 CAHME Board, Accreditation, Standards Council and Committee Members, plus the more than 35 CAHME site visitors who conducted 16 visits in 2011. The work of encouraging and challenging the accredited and candidate programs could not be done without the time and the expertise our volunteers bring. I also want to thank the CAHME staff for their hard work and good results.

2012 will be an important one for the CAHME organization. In the spring, the CAHME Corporate Members will gather with invited experts to examine the state of graduate healthcare management education in light of some changes in our environment. The Board is cognizant of the expense of providing the CAHME service, and with our increasing reliance on corporate sponsorship, we are concerned about this source of funding as healthcare reform advances.

The CAHME Board is aware that accreditation must be made more efficient because educational institutions are also “constrained” financially. CAHME hopes to begin the rollout of an electronic accreditation system (eAccreditation) in 2012. It is our intention to make self-study preparation and submission easier. We have had some growing pains but we are making progress and still feel that we have a solid development partner in Liaison International.

I am pleased to announce that effective January 10, 2012 “CAHME Outstanding Practices” competition will commence. Look to the CAHME website [www.cahme.org](http://www.cahme.org) to nominate outstanding practices found in our programs. This self-nomination process will be judged by volunteer judges to determine where there are noteworthy practices that should be shared. Winners will be announced in late spring 2012 for the first of what will become semi-annual submission cycles.

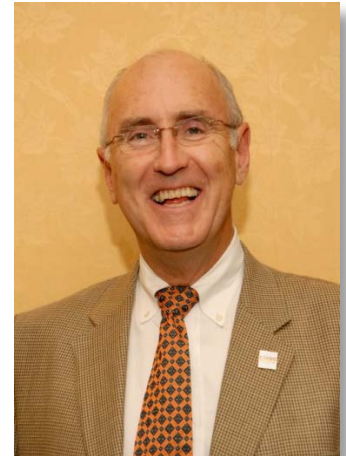

Our goals for this special meeting include:

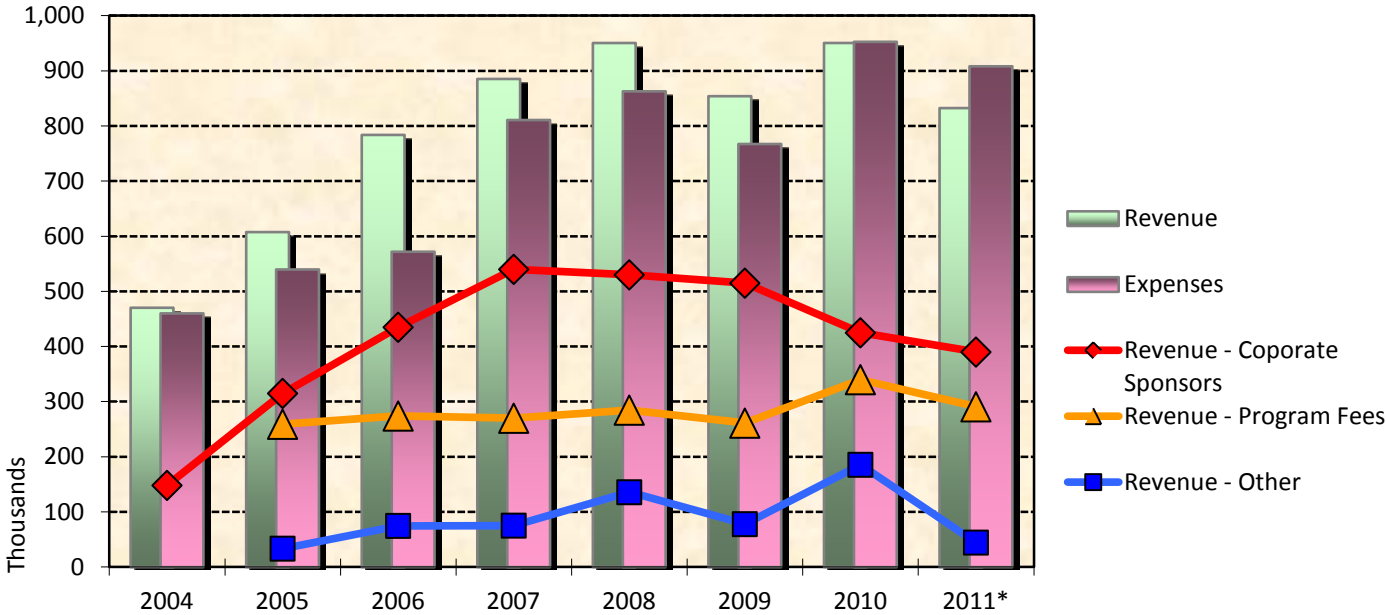
1. Develop a shared understanding of the challenge to our profession in transforming health and medical care in the next five years.
